

Call for Tutorial Proposals

The Organizing Committee of the 2016 IEEE International NEWCAS Conference (which will be jointly held with FTFC 2016) invites proposals for tutorials to be held on the first day of the conference (Sunday, June 26, 2016).

Each tutorial will be 3 hours long. Prospective tutorial speakers should submit proposals that include no more than 3 pages providing the following information:

- Title of the tutorial (up to ~10 words)
- Name(s) and affiliation(s) of the speaker(s)
- Extended Abstract (up to ~500 words), including importance and timeliness of the topic
- Table of content (as detailed as possible, up to one page)
- List of references (books and/or journal papers) related to the topic and (if applicable) published by the speaker(s)
- Brief biography (biographies) of the speaker(s) (300 words maximum per biography), highlighting (if applicable) prior experience in delivering conference tutorials.

Proposals will be evaluated based on their merits including the relevance and timeliness of the topic, and the qualifications of the speaker(s).
